



Prospective members – How to apply to join.

1. First the legal stuff.

If you haven't already done so, please read the Privacy Policy, Disclaimer and Constitution, all found via links in the Information for Prospective Members window <http://www.kkog.org.au>. Yes, yes, we know no one wants to read 38 pages of rules, but these rules govern our activities, so in the interests of "product disclosure" we have to say that you should read them.

Your continued application means that you accept all of the contents of all three documents.

2. Who is eligible to join?

Only owners of a Kimberley Karavan or Kruiser, or those who have ordered and can show that they have paid a deposit on a new or used Karavan or Kruiser are eligible to join.

3. Go to <http://www.kkog.org.au>

4. In the Information for Prospective Members window Click on the Join Now link. This link will take you to the online application form.

5. Read the introductory text to the application form. In particular, please be aware that all our communications are electronic, via email or via our on-line forum. We do not do paper mail because like you, we like to travel extensively and may not be home to receive and process paper mail from you or to send it to you.

We are an electronic organisation with both the committee and our membership spread across all states and territories of Australia and in New Zealand, USA and The Netherlands. All our meetings are electronic, our communications with members are electronic, our voting is electronic, and our records are electronic.

The only reason we have a postal address (and record yours) is that by law we must do that. However, it is impractical for us to use either in our day-to-day administration.

6. Complete and submit the online application form.

Ownership of a Karavan or Kruiser is a requirement for full membership. We treat chassis number and registration number together as prima facie evidence of ownership of your Karavan or Kruiser. Without both of those numbers your application may be rejected – unless of course you are in the ordering process and have paid a deposit, in which case please tell us in the "Other relevant information" section of the application form.

7. Once your application is accepted, the Secretary/Treasurer will email you a link that will take you to the KKOG Store where you will be able to purchase you KKOG Membership.

We do not accept cheques for membership transactions.

Why? Because we may not be home to receive your cheque for some months, the snails may eat it in the letterbox, Australia Post may not redirect your mail as instructed, the wind might blow it away, the rain might dissolve it – all of these have happened.

8. On receipt of your fees we will open an on-line account to the forum with the Username you have specified in the application form. We will email you advising you of the result of your application. If accepted we will advise you that your forum account has been opened with a temporary password, which you can change, when you first log on.

9. If any of your membership details change please note that it is your responsibility to inform membership@kkog.org.au or the secretary. Our systems are manual; we rely on you to keep us up to date!
